FORMER PG&E RENEWABLE ENERGY LEADER ENDORSES PROP. 7

Says Prop. 7 is much-needed spur to renewable energy

Internationally recognized renewable energy expert Carl Weinberg, former manager and leader of PG&E's energy research and development program, today announced his support for Proposition 7, the Solar and Clean Energy initiative. Mr. Weinberg is the principal of Weinberg Associates, which he founded in 1993 after 19 years with PG&E, where he grew an internationally respected program focused on renewable power.

"Prop. 7 is good public policy, and I urge voters to support it, as I will do," said Weinberg. "I've worked for the past 35 years to boost renewable energy in California. Prop. 7 is a big step forward towards a clean energy future."

"I have read the proposition carefully and cannot reconcile it with the statements made by those opposed to Proposition 7."

Proposition 7 will require public utilities in the State of California to provide electric power to their customers from clean, alternative energy generating sources at an accelerated rate. Renewable energy would account for 50% of California's power consumption by the year 2025.

Carl is an internationally recognized and respected spokesperson on renewable energy. Carl serves on boards and working level committees of numerous energy efficiency renewable energy organizations in the public and private sector. Carl is also chairman of the board for of the Regulatory Assistance Project (RAP), member of the Board of Center for Resource Solution and an associate of the California Council of Science and Technology
